

## Dental Fee Guide Increases for 2021

It's that time of year when most provincial and territorial dental associations release their annual dental fee guides. Typically, there is an overall increase for dental services provided by general practitioners.

We use the information contained in the provincial/territorial fee guides to establish reimbursement levels for the dental services your customers' employees receive and ensure that fees represent what the majority of dentist's charge.

The following chart outlines the fee guide increases announced for 2021. This will be emailed to Plan Administrators later this week.

Alberta	0%	January 1, 2021
British Columbia	3.96%	February 1, 2021
Manitoba	4.19%	January 1, 2021
Newfoundland & Labrador	5%	January 1, 2021
Northwest Territories/Nunavut	3%	January 1, 2021
Nova Scotia	3.39%	January 1, 2021
Ontario	4.60%	January 1, 2021
Prince Edward Island	2.61%	January 1, 2021
Quebec	4.20%	January 1, 2021
Saskatchewan	3.23%	January 1, 2021
